Success Criteria (A)

Able to hit consistently with topspin on groundstrokes from the baseline and hit with depth and height keeping opponent back within orange court using correct grip and stance

Able to trade with partner consistently, keeping control of the rally and hitting deep, keeping opponent back

Able to trade cross court, recovering to the middle of the baseline and able to hit deep keeping opponent

Able to build the point tactically to understand where to place the ball to build outcome of the point

Able to apply correct footwork towards the ball and split step each time

Able to volley using the correct technique, stand in the correct position on court, build and finish the point Able to serve overarm from baseline with correct grip and technique and serve with depth in to correct service boxes

Able to return the serve deep in to court, build and play point

Able to play a match using LTA Mini Tennis Orange format – best of 3 tiebreak

Success Criteria (B)

Able to competently hit groundstrokes with topspin and demonstrating correct technique with control Able to hit groundstrokes most of the time with depth and height

Able to trade cross court and recover but doesn't consistently hit deep

Able to apply footwork to the ball but doesn't split step or isn't on toes constantly

Able to trade with partner with control and competently from the baseline although may not be able to keep opponent back each time

Able to volley mostly using correct grip and technique to build the point

Able to serve overarm from the baseline with serves landing in the correct service boxes

Able to play points using LTA Mini Tennis Orange format with some assistance – best of 3 tiebreak

Success Criteria (C)

Able to hit majority of groundstrokes with topspin and control

Able to rally with partner using groundstrokes

Able to volley and return ball in court although grip may change from time to time

Able to apply some footwork to the ball and around the court

Able to serve overarm from the baseline with serve most of the time landing in correct service boxes

Able to understand how to play points using LTA Orange Mini Tennis format with assistance – best of 3 tiebreak
